CERI wins Top-rated Nonprofit Award for its Outstanding Work

Cambridge, Massachusetts, December 31, 2019 – Cancer Education and Research Institute® (CERI) announced today it has been honored with a prestigious ‘2019 Top-Rated Nonprofit Award’ by GreatNonprofits, the leading provider of user reviews of charities and nonprofits.

Cancer Education and Research Institute® (CERI) is the first and only simplified, multi-language global cancer organization. CERI’s educational programs have reached more than 2.6 million people worldwide from 192 countries.
